

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE ASSIGNMENT OF SALARIES AND WAGES DUE AND TO BECOME DUE FROM THE CITY OF ABILENE BY ITS OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES, PROVIDING CERTAIN EXCEPTIONS, PROVIDING A PENALTY AND PROVIDING FOR A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE 21ST DAY OF OCTOBER A. D. 1955.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE:

SECTION 1: From and after the effective date hereof, it shall be unlawful for any officer or employee of the City of Abilene to enter into any contract or agreement whereby said officer or employee attempts to assign all or any part of his salary or wages due or to become due to any other person, firm or corporation.

SECTION 2: Any such attempted assignment of salaries or wages shall be void and of no effect, and the City of Abilene shall not be bound thereby.

SECTION 3: The provisions hereof shall not apply to a voluntary assignment by such officer or employee of a portion of his salary or wages to the Abilene Federal Credit Union or for the payment of premiums of any insurance policies which may be held by reason of his employment with the City of Abilene, nor shall the provisions hereof be construed to prevent such assignment for the purpose of making contributions or payments to any retirement benefit funds provided by law, nor shall the provisions hereof be construed to prevent such assignment for Community Chest, nor shall the provisions hereof be construed to prevent such assignment for purchase of Government Bonds, nor shall the provisions hereof be construed to prevent assignment or payment for Social Security.

SECTION 4: Any person violating the provisions hereof shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not to exceed One Hundred and 00/100 Dollars (\$100.00).

SECTION 5: This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its final passage and publication as required by law.

SECTION 6: Ordinance No. 451 passed the 9th day of November 1951, and recorded in Volume 5, page 138 of the City Ordinances Records, entitled:

SHALL be and is hereby expressly repealed.

PASSED ON FIRST READING this the 7th day of October, A.D. 1955.

After said passage, notice of the time and place when and where said ordinance would be considered for final passage, and was published in "The Abilene Reporter News", a daily newspaper of general circulation in the City of Abilene, said publication being on the 11th day of October, 1955 at least one week prior to the time advertised, and the caption of said ordinance having been published for three successive days in said newspaper being the 11th, 12th, and 13th days of October, 1955. After such opportunity for the public to be heard, said ordinance was passed on its SECOND AND FINAL READING on the 21st day of October, 1955.
