

ORDINANCE NO. 691

ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, ANNEXING TO THE CITY OF ABILENE ALL THAT PROPERTY BEING A PORTION OF LAND BEING THE CONTINUATION OF NORTH SIXTH STREET AND LEGGETT DRIVE; GRANTING THE RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGES OF CITIZENS OF THE CITY TO THOSE RESIDING IN SAID TERRITORY; PROVIDING FOR AN EMERGENCY, PASSING THE SAME ON SECOND AND FINAL READING.

WHEREAS, the following described property is land or territory lying adjacent to the present city limits of the City of Abilene; and,

WHEREAS, it appears expedient and necessary to the Board of Commissioners of the City of Abilene, that said property be annexed for all purposes in accordance with the City Charter, and request has been made therefor, by the owners of all property therein contained:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE:

Section 1: That in accordance with Section 4 of the Charter of the City of Abilene, Texas, as amended, the following described property is hereby annexed to and included in the corporate limits of the City of Abilene, said territory being adjacent to the present city limit lines and being described as follows:

BEGINNING at the North East corner of Lot 12, Block 16, Section 2 of Oakwood Addition, said corner being in the South line of North 6th Street;

THENCE, in a Westerly direction with the South line of North 6th Street, a distance of 1241.4 feet to a point at the beginning of a curve bearing in a Southwesterly direction;

THENCE along said curve, bearing in a Southwesterly direction and having a radius of 555.1 feet, a distance of 372.9 feet to the end of said curve;

THENCE, in a Southwesterly direction a distance of 895.9 feet to a point at the beginning of a curve bearing in a Southerly direction;

THENCE, along said curve, bearing in a Southerly direction and having a radius of 424.56 feet a distance of 374.5 feet to the end of said curve;

THENCE, in a Southerly direction a distance of 400.54 feet to the North line of South 1st Street, being 10 feet East of the East line of Leggett Drive extended North across South 1st Street, and being the present city limits;

THENCE, in a Westerly direction with the North line of South 1st Street and the present city limits, a distance of 80 feet;

THENCE, in a Northerly direction a distance of 395.4 feet to a point at the beginning of a curve bearing in a Northeasterly direction;

THENCE, along said curve, bearing in a Northeasterly direction and having a radius of 504.56 feet, a distance of 445.1 feet to the end of said curve;

THENCE, in a Northeasterly direction, a distance of 895.9 feet to a point at the beginning of a curve bearing in an Easterly direction;

THENCE along said curve, bearing in an Easterly direction and having a radius of 635.1 feet, to a point where said curve intersects the present city limits;

THENCE, in an Easterly direction along the present city limits to a point, being the Southeast corner of Lot 22, Block H of Westview Park First Filing;

THENCE in a Southerly direction along the present city limits a distance of 80 feet to the place of BEGINNING.

Section 2: That upon final passage hereof, said property as annexed shall be part of the City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, and of Abilene Independent School District, and the property situated herein shall bear its pro-rata portion of the taxes levied by the City and the School District, and the inhabitants thereof shall be entitled to all the rights and privileges of all the citizens and shall be bound by the Acts, Ordinances, Rules and Regulations of the City.

PASSED ON FIRST READING This the 6th day of January, A. D. 1956.

After the passage of said ordinance on first reading, it being deemed necessary and it having been proven to the Commission that it was necessary to pass this ordinance to meet an emergency in accordance with Section 32 of the Charter of the City of Abilene, the rule requiring publication at least thirty (30) days prior to a public hearing and

requiring such hearing, was suspended by a vote of four members of the Board of Commissioners and said ordinance was read and passed on second and final reading on the 6th day of January, A. D. 1956.
