

Ordinance No. 711

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING A TRIANGULAR SHAPED TRACT OF LAND WHICH IS A PORTION OF LOT 18, BLOCK J. CONTINUATION NO. 1 OF WOODLAWN ADDITION WHICH LIES SOUTH OF THE NORTH LINE OF THE H. WARD SURVEY NO. 89, SAID SURVEY NO. 89 BEING THE PRESENT CITY LIMITS. SAID TRACT OF LAND IS BOUNDED ON THE SOUTH BY NORTH SIXTH STREET; ON THE NORTH BY THE PRESENT CITY LIMITS; AND ON THE SOUTHWEST BY AN ALLEY.

WHEREAS, a petition has been presented by Arthel Henson and Nathan Morris the owners of the property described as follows:

Being a triangular shaped tract of land which is a portion of Lot 18, Block J. Continuation of Number 1 of Woodlawn Addition, which lies South of the North line of the H. Ward Survey No. 89, said Survey No. 89 being the present City Limits. Said tract of land is bounded on the South by North Sixth Street; on the North by the present City Limits; and on the Southwest by an alley.

That said hereinabove described property be annexed to the City of Abilene, now therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

Section 1: That the following described property lying immediately adjacent to and outside the city limits of the City of Abilene:

Being a triangular shaped tract of land which is a portion of Lot 18, Block J. Continuation Number 1 of Woodlawn Addition, which lies South of the North line of the H. Ward Survey No. 89, said Survey No. 89 being the present city limits. Said tract of land is bounded on the South by North Sixth Street; an the North by the present City Limits; and on the Southwest by an alley.

be and the same is hereby annexed to the City of Abilene.

Section 2: Passed on its first reading the 23rd day of March, 1956.

Section 3: The fact that all of said property is owned by Arthel Henson and Nathan Morris, the petitioners, and that Section 4 of the Charter of the City of Abilene, as amended, allows the annexation of such property without giving notice

and advertising same, together with the fact that certain existing conditions in said area creating an emergency requiring suspension of the rule provided in Section 32 of the City Charter requiring ordinances to be read and passed in two separate meetings of the Board of Commissioners and said rule is hereby suspended and said ordinance is hereby read and passed at one and the same meeting.

Section 4: Passed on second and final reading the 23rd day of March, 1956.

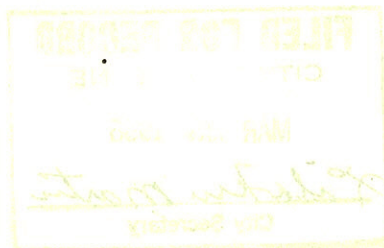

To the honorable Mayor and Commissioners of the City of Abilene.


