ORDINANCE NO. 728

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 9 SUBSECTION (1) OF ORDINANCE NO. 687 PASSED AND APPROVED ON THE 16TH DAY OF DECEMBER, 1955; CALLING FOR A PUBLIC HEARING JUNE 29, 1956.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

Section 1: That Section 9, Subsection (i) of Ordinance No. 687 passed and approved on the 16th day of December, 1955, be and the same is hereby amended, so as to hereafter read as follows:

> (i) All boats operated on the waters of Lake Fort Phantom shall be licensed with the City of Abilene. The license number shall be painted or exhibited on both sides of the boat on the hull above the water line in letters not less than four and one-half inches high and three and one-half inches wide. Temporary permits may be issued for boats not to remain in the waters of Lake Fort Phantom more than five consecutive days."

Section 2: PASSED on first reading this the 15th

day of June, 1956.
