

ORDINANCE NO. 1095

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF ABILENE ABANDONING A PORTION OF BEECHWOOD LANE, AND DECLARING THAT SAID STREET IS NOT NECESSARY TO THE CITY OF ABILENE AS A PUBLIC WAY;

WHEREAS, the present owners owning adjoining property desire that such street be abandoned.

WHEREAS, said street as dedicated has never been opened up for public use.

SECTION I: That the City of Abilene does hereby abandon a portion of Beechwood lane for public use; said street being located between North 12th Street and State Street.

SECTION II: That the City declares that such street is not necessary to the City and that it has never been used as a street and the City does not foresee that such street will be needed by the public.

PASSED ON FIRST READING This the 27th day of April, A.D., 1961.

After said passage a notice of time and place, where and when said ordinance would be given a public hearing and considered for final passage was published in the Abilene Reporter-News, a daily newspaper of general circulation in the City of Abilene, said publication being on the 2nd day of May, 1961, the same being more than one(1) week prior to the time designated for said hearing. After such opportunity for the public to be heard, said ordinance was passed on second and final hearing.
