

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE

CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, :

Ord # 1111

Section 1: That Chapter 39 of The Code of The City of Abilene, Texas,

1957, as amended, be, and the same is hereby, further amended by adding

the following section thereto:

"Sec. 1A: REGULATION OF DRY MILK PRODUCTS. All dry

milk products manufactured, sold, or offered for sale, for use in

the commercial preparation of Grade A pasteurized milk products

either regulated by the Code of the City of Abilene, Texas, 1957,

as amended, or used for such purpose within the Corporate

Limits of the City of Abilene or its police jurisdiction, shall be

regulated in accordance with the terms of the unbridged form

of the publication of the United States Department of Health,

Education and Welfare, Public Health Service, entitled Grade A

Dry Milk Products - A Recommended Sanitation Ordinance and

Code for Dry Milk Products used in Grade A Pasteurized Milk

Products - Supplement I to the Milk Ordinance and Code, 1953,

Recommendations of the Public Health Service, a certified copy

of which shall be on file in the Office of the City Secretary of

the City of Abilene, and providing that the words "municipality

or" in said unbridged form shall be understood to refer to the

City of Abilene, Texas, and further, that the words "Health

Officer" shall be understood to refer to the Director of the

Abilene-Taylor County Health Department."

Section 2: That any person who shall violate any provision of this

ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof

shall be fined an amount not to exceed Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00).

Each and every violation of the provisions of this ordinance shall constitute

a separate offense.

PASSED ON FIRST READING this 24th day of August, A. D. 1961.
