AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ABILENE ANNEXING TO THE CITY OF ABILENE A PORTION OF THE WYLIE COMMUNITY TO THE CITY OF ABILENE, TAYLOR COUNTY, TEXAS; PROVIDING FOR THE ZONING OF THE SAME AND GRANTING THE RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGES OF THE CITIZENS OF THE CITY TO THOSE RESIDING IN SAID TERRITORY; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE 10th DAY OF August A. D., 1961.

WHEREAS, the following described property is land or territory lying adjacent to the present city limits of the City of Abilene; and,

WHEREAS, it appears expedient and necessary to the Board of Commissioners of the City of Abilene, that said property be annexed for all purposes in accordance with the City Charter, and request has been made therefor;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

SECTION I: That in accordance with Section 4 of the Charter of the City of Abilene, Texas, as amended, the following described property is hereby annexed to and included in the corporate limits of the City of Abilene, said territory being adjacent to the present city limit lines and being described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in the North line of Curry Lane in the present city limits line at their intersection with the centerline of Catclaw Creek;

THENCE in a southerly direction with the meanders of the centerline of Catclaw Creek to a point 500 feet North of the centerline of a county line which runs East and West through Wylie;

THENCE West 850 feet;

THENCE South 1000 feet;

THENCE East to the centerline of said Catclaw Creek;

THENCE in a southerly direction with the meanders of the centerline of Catclaw Creek to a point 500' east of and measured at right angles to the East ROW line of the Buffalo Gap Road;

THENCE in a northeasterly direction parallel to and 500' East

SECTION V: That a public hearing be held at 1:30 o'clock P. M. on the 10th day of August, A. D., 1961, in the chambers of the Board of Commissioners at the City Hall in Abilene, Texas, at which time all interested persons shall be given full opportunity to be heard in opposition or support of said annexation.

PASSED ON FIRST READING This the 29th day of June,

A. D., 1961.

After said passage, said ordinance was published in final form in the Abilene Reporter-News, a daily newspaper published in the City of Abilene, on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of July, A. D., 1961, which date was more than 30 days prior to the date of the public hearing and the date that the same was finally acted upon by the Board of Commissioners.

of, measured at right angles to, the said East ROW line of Buffalo Gap Road to a point 500' South of and measured at right angles to the South ROW line of a county road;

THENCE East along a line 500' South of measured at right angles to the South line of said county road to a point in the East line of W. E. Vaughan Survey;

THENCE North with the East line of said W. E. Vaughan Survey to the North line of said county road;

THENCE East with the North line of said county road to its intersection with the centerline of Buttonwillow Creek;

THENCE in a northeasterly direction with the centerline of said Buttonwillow Creek to a point in the North line of J. Smith Survey and a point in the present city limits;

THENCE West with the present city limits line and the North line of said J. Smith Survey to the West ROW line of the Lake Abilene water supply line;

THENCE in a northerly direction with said present city limit line along said West ROW line to a point 500' southwest of and measured at right angles to the South ROW line of U.S. Hwy. 83, Freeway;

THENCE with the present city limit line in a northwesterly direction parallel to and 500' at right angles to the said South ROW to a point in the North ROW line of Curry Lane, a county road. THENCE West to the point of beginning.

SECTION II: That upon final passage hereof, said property as annexed, shall be part of the City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, and the property situated herein shall bear its pro-rata portion of the taxes levied by the City, and the inhabitants thereof shall be entitled to all the rights and privileges of all the citizens and shall be bound by the Acts, Ordinances, Rules and Regulations of the City.

SECTION III: Said property shall be zoned as follows:  
Temporary "A".

SECTION IV: If any provisions of this Ordinance of the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall be held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the provision or application of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of the Ordinance are declared to be severable.
