

ORDINANCE NO. 1153

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE CLOSING, VACATING, AND ABANDONING A PORTION OF LOWDEN STREET BETWEEN THE EAST PROPERTY LINE OF STADIUM WAY AND THE WEST PROPERTY LINE OF INTERSTATE HIGHWAY NO. 20.

WHEREAS, a county road opened for public use, later becoming an extension of Lowden Street, now dead-ends at the West Property Line of Inter-state Highway No. 20 and is of no further use as a public roadway; and,

WHEREAS, abutting property owners have requested that this extension of Lowden Street be closed and it is the opinion of the Board of Commissioners of the City of Abilene that the closing, vacating and abandoning of that portion of Lowden Street between the East Property Line of Stadium Way and the West Property Line of Interstate Highway No. 20 is in the public interest; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

Section 1. That the City of Abilene does hereby close, vacate and abandon that portion of Lowden Street between the East Property Line of Stadium Way and the West Property Line of Interstate Highway No. 20.

Section 2: That the abandoned street right-of-way be quitclaimed to the abutting property owners, C.M. Caldwell and Abilene Christian College.

PASSED ON FIRST READING this 4th day of January, A.D. 1962.

After said passage a notice of time and place, where and when said ordinance would be given a public hearing and considered for final passage was published in the Abilene Reporter-News, a daily newspaper of general circulation in the City of Abilene, said publication being on the 9th day of January, 1962, the same being more than one (1) week prior to the time designated for said hearing. After such opportunity for the public to be heard, said ordinance was passed on second and final reading.
