

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 59 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, 1957, "TRAFFIC CODE", BY ADDING TO SCHEDULE X, STOPPING, STANDING OR PARKING PROHIBITED DURING CERTAIN HOURS ON CERTAIN STREETS, TWO RESTRICTIONS ON SAYLES BOULEVARD; PROVIDING A PENALTY; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND CALLING A PUBLIC HEARING.

WHEREAS, The Traffic Engineer of the City of Abilene has established several traffic regulations on an experimental basis as required by ordinance and said regulations have proved a desirable aid to traffic safety within the City of Abilene and the Traffic Engineer has recommended that such regulations be made permanent; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

Section 1: That Schedule X, Chapter 59, of The Code of The City of Abilene, Texas, 1957, commonly known as the Traffic Code, be, and the same is hereby, amended so as to hereafter read as follows:

"Schedule X, STOPPING, STANDING OR PARKING PROHIBITED DURING CERTAIN HOURS ON CERTAIN STREETS.

1. West side of Sayles Boulevard from South 9th to South 14th  
4:00 P. M. to 6:00 P. M.  
Week Days only
2. East side of Sayles Boulevard from South 9th to South 14th  
7:00 A. M. to 9:00 A. M.  
Week Days only

Section 2: That any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be subject to a fine not to exceed Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00).

Section 3: That should any portion of this ordinance be held to be invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall in no way affect the remaining portions of this ordinance or the remaining sections of The Code of the City of Abilene, Texas, 1957.
