

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AMENDING SECTION 6, CHAPTER 52, OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, 1957, BY ESTABLISHING SUMMER WATER RATES FOR THE MONTHS OF JULY, AUGUST AND SEPTEMBER, 1962.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

Section 1: That Section 52-6 of Chapter 52 of The Code of The City of Abilene, Texas, 1957, as amended, be and the same is hereby further amended by providing a new section, 52-6(a), which shall read as follows:

"Sec. 52-6(a). That the following rates per month or fraction thereof shall be the rates charged for water furnished to consumers within the corporate limits of the City of Abilene during the months of July, August and September, 1962, only:

Minimum bill	2, 000 gallons	\$2. 00
Next	10, 000 gallons	.30 per thousand gallons
All over	12, 000 gallons	. 25 per thousand gallons

Provided, however, that the Parks and Public Recreation Department of the City of Abilene and the Maxwell Municipal Golf Course shall not be charged for water in excess of their actual minimum consumption based on their average consumption for the years 1960 and 1961 during the months of July, August and September, 1962, only.

PASSED ON FIRST READING this 5th day of July, A. D. 1962.
