

ORDINANCE NO. 122

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, PROVIDING FOR THE EXTENSION OF THE BOUNDARY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE AND THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN TERRITORY CONSISTING OF APPROXIMATELY 2,333.6 ACRES OF LAND, TO-WIT: BEGINNING AT A POINT WHICH IS THE INTERSECTION OF THE NORTHEASTERLY EXTENSION OF THE EAST RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF THAT COUNTY ROAD COMMONLY CALLED CHAPEL HILL ROAD AND A LINE 500 FEET NORTH OF, PARALLEL TO AND MEASURED AT RIGHT ANGLES TO THE NORTH RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF INTERSTATE HIGHWAY 20, SAID POINT NOW LYING IN THE NORTHWESTERLY CORPORATE LIMITS OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AND SAID POINT LYING WITHIN SECTION 30 OF TEXAS AND PACIFIC BLOCK 16; THENCE IN A WESTERLY DIRECTION 500 FEET NORTH OF AND PARALLEL TO THE NORTH RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF INTERSTATE HIGHWAY 20 TO THE NORTH-SOUTH CENTER LINE OF SECTION 28 OF TEXAS AND PACIFIC BLOCK 16, SAID CENTER LINE BEING THE EAST CORPORATE LIMITS OF TYE, TEXAS; THENCE SOUTH 13 DEGREES EAST ALONG THE CENTER LINE OF SECTION 28 OF T&P BLOCK 16 AND CONTINUING ALONG THE CENTER LINE OF SECTION 35 OF T&P BLOCK 16 UNTIL SAID LINE INTERSECTS THE SOUTH RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF THE INTERCHANGE OF INTERSTATE HIGHWAY 20 AND U. S. HIGHWAY 80; THENCE IN A SOUTHEASTERLY DIRECTION ALONG THE SOUTH RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF SAID INTERSTATE HIGHWAY 20 285 FEET TO A POINT; THENCE SOUTH 36 DEGREES 38 MINUTES EAST 163 FEET ALONG SAID SOUTH RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE TO A POINT IN THE NORTH RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF OLD U. S. HIGHWAY 80; THENCE NORTH 88 DEGREES 30 MINUTES WEST ALONG THE NORTH RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF OLD U. S. HIGHWAY 80 A DISTANCE OF 1684 FEET TO A POINT; THENCE SOUTH 13 DEGREES EAST 4139.5 FEET TO A POINT; THENCE SOUTH 79 DEGREES 26 MINUTES WEST ALONG THE SOUTH LINE OF SECTION 35 OF T&P BLOCK 16 1066 FEET TO A POINT; THENCE SOUTH 14 DEGREES 34 MINUTES EAST 2696 FEET TO THE BOUNDARY LINE OF DYESS AIR FORCE BASE RESERVATION; THENCE IN AN EASTERLY DIRECTION ALONG SAID BOUNDARY LINE AND FOLLOWING THE PERIMETER OF THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF ABILENE, TEXAS, TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING; WHICH TERRITORY LIES ADJACENT TO AND ADJOINS THE PRESENT BOUNDARY LIMIT OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS; AND CALLING A PUBLIC HEARING.

WHEREAS, a public hearing before the City Council of the City of Abilene,

Texas, where all interested persons were provided with an opportunity to be heard on the proposed annexation of the territory hereinafter described, was held at 8:30 A. M. on the 13th day of August, 1964, which date is not more than twenty nor less than ten days prior to the institution of annexation proceedings; and

WHEREAS, notice of such public hearing was published in a newspaper having general circulation in the City of Abilene, Texas, and in the herein described territory on the 27th day of July, A. D. 1964, which date is not more than twenty nor less than ten days prior to the date of such public hearing; and,

WHEREAS, the total corporate area of the City of Abilene, Texas, on the first

day of January, 1964, was 42,630 acres; and,

WHEREAS, the population of the City of Abilene, Texas, is 101,649 inhabitants; and,

WHEREAS, the herein described territory lies within the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the City of Abilene, Texas; and,

WHEREAS, the hereinafter described territory contains 2,333.6 acres; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

Section 1: That the following described land and territory lying adjacent to and adjoining the City of Abilene, Texas, is hereby added and annexed to the City of Abilene, Texas, and said territory hereinafter described shall hereafter be included within the boundary limits of the City of Abilene, Texas, and the present boundary limits of such city, at the various points contiguous to the area hereinafter described, are altered and amended so as to include said area within the corporate limits of the City of Abilene, Texas, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point which is the intersection of the northeasterly extension of the East right-of-way line of that county road commonly called Chapel Hill Road and a line 500 feet North of, parallel to and measured at right angles to the North right-of-way line of Interstate Highway 20, said point now lying in the northwesterly corporate limits of Abilene, Texas, and said point lying within Section 30 of Texas and Pacific Block 16;

THENCE in a westerly direction 500 feet North of and parallel to the North right-of-way line of Interstate Highway 20 to the North-South center line of Section 28 of Texas and Pacific Block 16, said center line being the East corporate limits of Tye, Texas;

THENCE S 13 deg E along the center line of Section 28 of T&P Block 16 and continuing along the center line of Section 35 of T&P Block 16 until said line intersects the South right-of-way line of the interchange of Interstate Highway 20 and U. S. Highway 80;

THENCE North 88 deg 30 min West along the North right-of-way line of old U. S. Highway 80 a distance of 1684 feet to a point;

THENCE South 13 deg East 4139.5 feet to a point;

THENCE South 79 deg 26 min West along the South line of Section 35 of T&P Block 16, 1066 feet to a point;

THENCE South 14 deg 34 min East 2696 feet to the boundary line of Dyess Air Force Base Reservation;

THENCE in an easterly direction along said boundary line and following the perimeter of the corporate limits of Abilene, Texas, to the point of intersection with the southerly extension of the East right-of-way line

of that county road commonly called Chapel Hill Road;
THENCE in a northeasterly direction along the East right-of-way
line of Chapel Hill Road and continuing along an extension of said
East right-of-way line and following the perimeter of the corporate
limits of Abilene, Texas, to the point of beginning.

Section 2: That the above described territory and the area so annexed shall be
a part of the City of Abilene and the property so added hereby shall bear its pro rata
part of the taxes levied by the City of Abilene, and the inhabitants thereof shall be
entitled to all of the rights and privileges of all the citizens and shall be bound by the
acts, ordinances, resolutions and regulations of the City of Abilene.

Section 3: That this ordinance shall be published and passed in the manner
provided in Section 4 of the Charter of the City of Abilene, Texas, and the City Secretary
shall give notice that a public hearing shall be held thereon at 8:30 A. M. on September
24, 1964, in the Council Room of the City Hall, City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas.
