

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, ESTABLISHING TWENTY (20) POSITIONS FOR DEPUTY CORPORATION COURT CLERKS FOR THE CITY OF ABILENE.

WHEREAS, Section 79 of the Charter of the City of Abilene, Texas, requires that the City Council provide for such deputy corporation court clerks as may be necessary; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE,

TEXAS:

Section 1: That there be, and is hereby, created Twenty (20) positions for Deputy Corporation Court Clerks for the Corporation Court of the City of Abilene.

Section 2: That appointments to fill the above positions shall be made by the Clerk of Corporation Court and approved by the City Manager.

Section 3: That all prior ordinances creating the position of Deputy Corporation Court Clerks for the City of Abilene be, and the same are hereby, in all things repealed.
