AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AMENDING SECTION 52-6 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, 1957, AS AMENDED, BY PROVIDING FOR THE SALE OF TREATED WATER TO SENIOR COLLEGES, UNIVERSITIES AND CERTAIN OTHER PRIVATE SCHOOLS LOCATED WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE AT A RATE LOWER THAN REGULAR CONSUMERS; AND PROVIDING FOR PASSAGE OF SAID ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, senior colleges, universities and certain other private schools within the city limits of the City of Abilene maintain extensive water distribution systems within the boundaries of their respective campuses; and,

WHEREAS, the expense of installation, maintenance and upkeep of such water distribution systems is borne by such respective colleges, universities or other private school at no expense to the City of Abilene; and,

WHEREAS, the cost of providing treated water to such colleges, universities and other private schools is less because of the existence and maintenance of such distribution systems; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

Section 1: That Section 52-6 of The Code of The City of Abilene, Texas, 1957, as amended, be and the same is hereby further amended by adding thereto the following:

"COLLEGES, UNIVERSITIES, AND PRIVATE SCHOOLS: Senior colleges, universities, St. Joseph's Academy and Central Catholic High School, located within the corporate limits of the City of Abilene shall be charged for water furnished to such college, university or private school at a rate ~~five~~ ²⁵ cents (\$~~.05~~ ^{.25}) less than the rate charged to other water consumers located within such corporate limits. "
