

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, CHANGING THE NAMES OF PORTIONS OF STREETS HEREIN DESCRIBED; AND DIRECTING THE PLANNING DIRECTOR TO CHANGE THE OFFICIAL MAPS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE TO INDICATE SUCH CHANGES.

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission of the City of Abilene has heretofore considered a proposal for re-naming certain streets within the corporate limits of the City of Abilene, and in connection therewith held a public hearing and gave notice as required by the laws of the State of Texas and the City of Abilene, and, following said hearing, has made its report and recommendations to the City Council; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE,

TEXAS:

Section 1: That the recently completed public street, connecting East South 11th and a southerly extension of Maple Street, be and is hereby officially designated as Maple Street.

Section 2: That that portion of a public roadway extending in a southerly direction from the easternmost end of South 15th Street toward Abilene State School to its intersection with the southernmost end of the new construction, formerly designated as Maple Street, be and is hereby changed to Bass Drive.

Section 3: That that portion of Nonesuch Road between Brook Hollow Drive and the eastern right of way line of Winters Freeway be and is hereby re-named Brief Street.

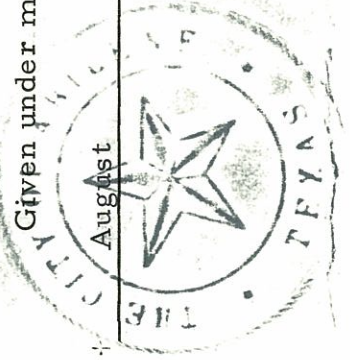
