

ORDINANCE NO. 276

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 215 AND CORRECTING THE DESCRIPTION OF THE ABANDONMENT OF A PORTION OF SANDY STREET.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Abilene enacted Ordinance No. 215 on the 23rd day of November, 1965, which ordinance abandoned a portion of Sandy Street east of the west right of way line of Stadium Way to the Southwest corner of the Tutt Subdivision; and,

WHEREAS, the description of the portion of Sandy Street to be abandoned was defective; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the public to amend such description; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

Section 1: That the description contained in Section 1 of Ordinance No. 215 be, and is hereby amended by substituting the following description therefor:

All of Sandy Street from the West right of way line of Stadium Way, which is also at right angles to the Texas and Pacific Railroad Co. centerline station 21 379 + 65.56 east a distance of approximately 3,145.6' to the southwest corner of Tutt Subdivision which is also at right angle to Texas & Pacific Railroad Co. centerline station 21 348 + 20.
