

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, CHANGING THE NAME OF MARINDA ROAD TO ARROWHEAD DRIVE.

WHEREAS, a certain street in the southwest part of the City of Abilene between Farm to Market Road 89 and U.S. Highway 83 is one continuous road but has a different name along portions of said road; and

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the City's Planning and Zoning Commission that this entire street should be named Arrowhead Drive to avoid confusion of the public and residents of the area; and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council that such street should be named Arrowhead Drive; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the street known as Marinda Road be changed and will hereafter be known as Arrowhead Drive.

PART 2: That the City Engineer be, and is hereby, authorized and directed to change his maps, plats and records to indicate such name.

PART 3: That the City Planning Department be, and is hereby, authorized and directed to change its maps, plats and records to reflect such name and further that the City Planning Department shall provide notice of the naming of such street to any other City department, including the Fire and Police Departments, affected by such change.

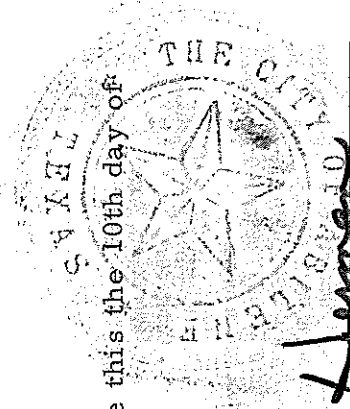
