

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, CHANGING THE NAME OF THE PORTION OF INDUSTRIAL BOULEVARD EAST OF MAPLE STREET, TO EAST INDUSTRIAL BOULEVARD.

WHEREAS, a portion of Industrial Boulevard in the City of Abilene, extends east of Maple Street; and,

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the City's Planning and Zoning Commission that the portion of Industrial Boulevard extending east of Maple Street should be named East Industrial Boulevard; and,

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council that the portion of Industrial Boulevard extending east of Maple Street should be named East Industrial Boulevard; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the portion of Industrial Boulevard extending east of Maple Street be changed and will hereafter be known as East Industrial Boulevard.

PART 2: That the City Engineer be, and is hereby authorized and directed to change his maps, plats and records to indicate such name to be the proper name of that portion of the street in question.

PART 3: That the City Planning Department be, and is hereby authorized and directed to change its maps, plats and records to reflect such name change, and further that the City Planning Department shall provide notice of the naming of such street to all other City departments, including the Fire and Police Departments.
