AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS RENAMING STADIUM WAY AS JUDGE ELY BOULEVARD.

WHEREAS, Stadium Way in the City of Abilene extends south of I-20 to E. S. 11th Street; and,

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Commission of the City of Abilene that Stadium Way should be named in honor of Judge W. R. Ely; and,

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council that Stadium Way should be named Judge Ely Boulevard; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That Stadium Way which extends south from I-20 to E. S. 11th Street be named and will hereafter be known as Judge Ely Boulevard.

PART 2: That the City Engineer be and is hereby authorized and directed to change his maps, plats and records to include such name to be the proper name of the street above described.

PART 3: That the City Planning and Zoning Department be, and is hereby authorized and directed to change its maps, plats and records to reflect such name change, and further that the City Planning and Zoning Department shall provide notice of the renaming of such street to all other City departments including Fire and Police Departments.

PART 4: That hereafter, that portion of Judge Ely Boulevard north of T. & P. Railroad shall be known as North Judge Ely Boulevard, and that portion south of T. & P. Railroad shall be known as South Judge Ely Boulevard.

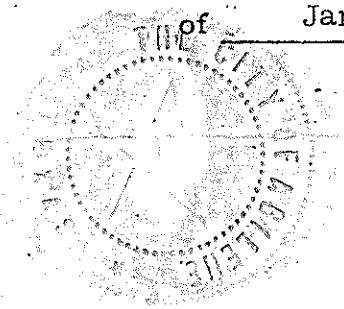
