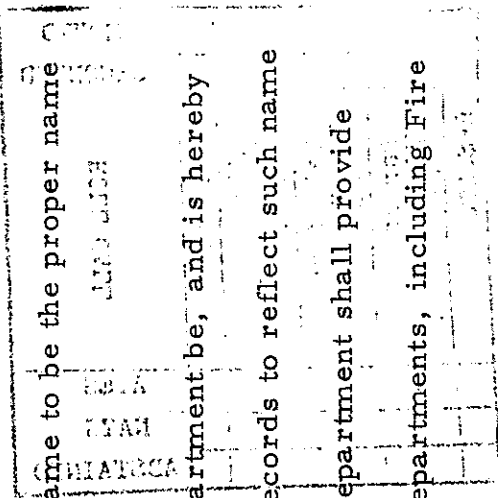
WHEREAS, Brian Parkway in the City of Abilene extends south of Rebecca Lane, dead-ending; and,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That Brian Parkway, which extends south of Rebecca Lane, dead-ending, be named and will hereafter be known as Catclaw Drive.

PART 2: That the City Engineer be and is hereby authorized and directed to change his maps, plats and records to include such name to be the proper name of the street above described.



PART 3: That the City Planning and Zoning Department be, and is hereby authorized and directed to change its maps, plats and records to reflect such name change, and further that the City Planning and Zoning Department shall provide notice of the renaming of such street to all other City departments, including Fire and Police Departments.

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Commission of the City of Abilene that Brian Parkway should be renamed Catclaw Drive; and,

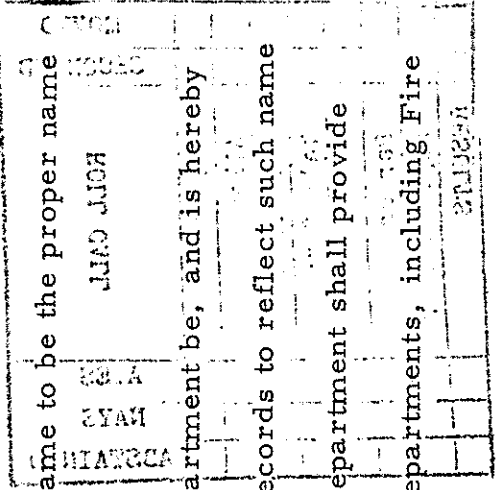
WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council that Brian Parkway should be renamed Catclaw Drive; now, therefore,

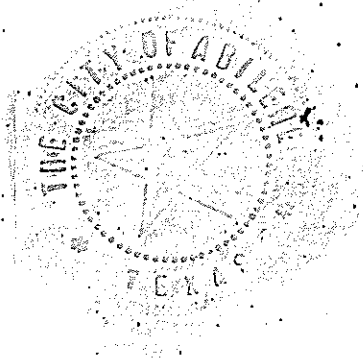
