ORDINANCE NO. 798

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 19, OFFENSES - MISCELLANEOUS, OF THE ABILENE MUNICIPAL CODE; DELETING REFERENCES TO STATE BRIDGES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That Chapter 19, Offenses - Miscellaneous, of the Abilene Municipal Code be, and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 19-5.1 to delete therefrom Subsection (c) so that said Section 19-5.1 shall hereafter read as follows:

Sec. 19-5.1 Bridges--Fishing, loitering, etc., on or under bridges.

(a) It shall be unlawful for any person to fish from the road surface or deck of any bridge in the city limits.

(b) It shall be unlawful for any person to fish or camp under any bridge or within the right of way of any street or road within the city limits.


PART 2: That any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this chapter shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00). Each such violation which shall continue, or be permitted to continue, shall be deemed a separate offense.

PART 3: This ordinance shall become effective ten (10) days after its publication in the newspaper as required by the provisions of Article II, Section 19, of the Abilene City Charter.
