ORDINANCE NO. 936

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, RENAMING FAIRMOUNT, FROM SOUTH CLACK TO CORSICANA, TO FAIRMONT.

WHEREAS, various residents living on Fairmount, from South Clack to Corsicana, have requested that such street name be changed to Fairmont; and,

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council that Fairmount, from South Clack to Corsicana, should be renamed Fairmont; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That Fairmount, from South Clack to Corsicana, be renamed and will hereafter be known as Fairmont.

PART 2: That the City Engineer be and is hereby authorized and directed to change his maps, plats and records to include such name to be the proper name of the street above described.

PART 3: That the City Planning and Community Development Department be and is hereby authorized and directed to change its maps, plats and records to reflect such name change and further that the City Planning and Community Development Department shall provide notice of the renaming of such street to all other city departments including Fire and Police Departments.
