ORDINANCE NO. 975

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 20, PARKS AND RECREATION, OF THE ABILENE MUNICIPAL CODE; REPEALING CURRENT FEE SCHEDULE AND PROVIDING FOR NEW FEES FOR GOLF AND TENNIS; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE AND A PENALTY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That Ordinance No. 400, passed on second reading on October 10, 1968 and Section 20-8, Maxwell Municipal Golf Course - Membership Dues and Restrictions, of Chapter 20, Parks and Recreation, of the Abilene Municipal Code, are hereby repealed.

PART 2: That Section 20-8, Golf and Tennis Fees and Terms For Concessions and Lessons, Etc., of Chapter 20, Parks and Recreation, of the Abilene Municipal Code, be, and shall hereafter read as follows:

20-8. Golf and Tennis Fees and Terms For Concessions and Lessons, Etc.

- (a) Maxwell Golf Course
 - (1) Weekday Green Fee - \$2.50
 - (2) Weekend & Holiday Green Fee - \$3.00
 - (3) Weekend Reservation - \$1.00
 - (4) Annual Membership - \$150, \$35 each additional family member
 - (5) Senior Citizen Membership (62 & over) - \$85 - weekday only
 - (6) Concessions - 10% of gross to city
 - (7) Golf Cars - 15% gross to city
 - (8) Pro Shop Sales - 10% of gross to city
 - (9) Lessons - 5% of gross to city

(b) Rose Tennis Center

- (1) Court Fee - \$1.00 per 1-1/2 hrs.
- (2) Family Membership - \$85
- (3) Adult Membership - \$50
- (4) Junior Membership - \$18
- (5) Concessions - 10% of gross to city
- (6) Pro Shop Sales - 10% of gross to city
- (7) Lessons - 5% of gross to city

PART 3: That if any provision of any section of this ordinance shall be held to be void or unconstitutional such holding shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance, which shall remain in full force and effect.

PART 4: That any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this chapter shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00). Each day

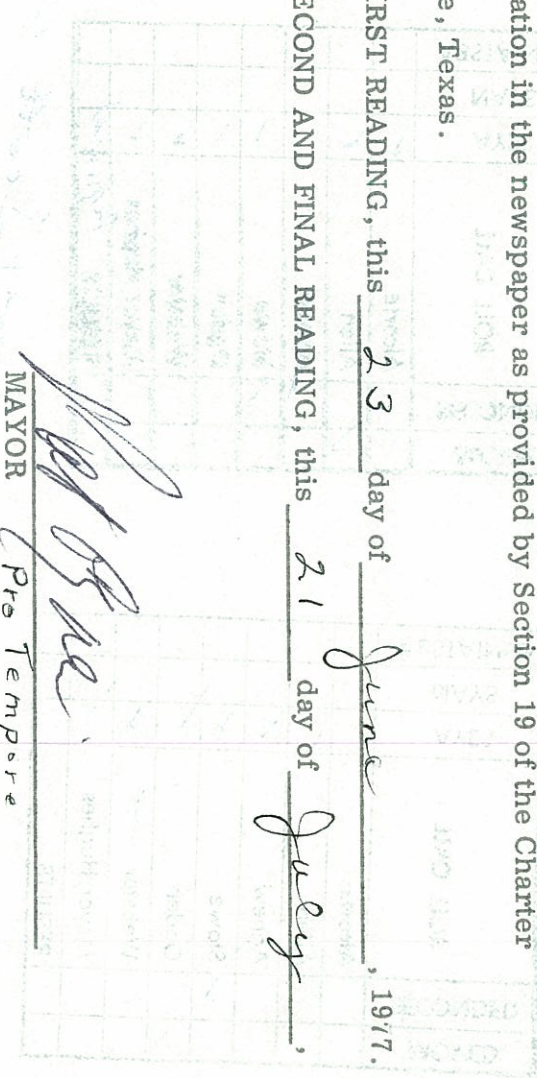
such violation shall continue, or be permitted to continue, shall be deemed a separate offense.

PART 5: Said ordinance, being a penal ordinance, becomes effective ten (10) days after its publication in the newspaper as provided by Section 19 of the Charter of the City of Abilene, Texas.
