ORDINANCE NO. 1015

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, PROVIDING FOR THE EXTENSION OF THE BOUNDARY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AND THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN TERRITORY LYING ADJACENT TO AND ADJOINING THE PRESENT BOUNDARY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, Section 4 of the Charter of the City of Abilene, Texas, provides that the City shall have the power, by ordinance, to fix and change the boundaries and limits of the City and to provide for the extension of said boundaries and limits and the annexation of additional territory lying adjacent to the City with or without the consent of the territory and inhabitants thereof annexed; and,

WHEREAS, notice of a public hearing, pursuant to Article 970a, the Texas Municipal Annexation Act, was published in the Abilene Reporter News, a newspaper having a general circulation in the City of Abilene, Texas, on the 17th day of October, 1977, which date was not more than twenty (20) nor less than ten (10) days prior to the date of a public hearing on said annexation; and,

WHEREAS, a public hearing before the City Council of the City of Abilene, Texas, where all interested persons were provided with an opportunity to be heard on said proposed annexation, was held at City Hall on the 3rd day of November, 1977, which date was not more than twenty (20) nor less than ten (10) days prior to the institution of annexation proceedings (first reading of this Ordinance); and,

WHEREAS, said territory lies adjacent to and adjoins the present boundaries of the City of Abilene, Texas; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the following described land and territory lying adjacent to and adjoining the present boundaries of the City of Abilene, Texas, is hereby added and annexed to the City of Abilene, Texas, and said territory hereinafter described shall hereafter be included within the boundary limits of the City of Abilene, Texas, and the present boundary limits of the City of Abilene, at the various points contiguous to the area hereinafter described, are altered and amended so as to include said area within the corporate limits of the City of Abilene, Texas, to-wit:

Beginning at a point in the present city limits where the North right-of-way line of Antilley Drive if extended intersects the present city limits line, said point being 100 feet East of U. S. Highway 83-84.

Thence North along the present city limits line which is 100 feet East of and parallel to the East right-of-way line of Highway 83-84 to a point 750 feet South of the North Boundary Line of Section 9, Lunatic Asylum Lands in Taylor County, Texas;

Thence West along the present city limits line of a point 500 feet West of the Southwest right-of-way line of U. S. Highway 83-84 also being the intersection of Winters Freeway and Highway 83-84;

Thence in a Northwesterly direction parallel to and 500 feet Southwest of the Southwest right-of-way line of Winters Freeway to a point in the South Boundary Line of Section 65, Blind Asylum Lands, Taylor County, Texas;

Thence West to a point where the South Boundary Line of Section 65, Blind Asylum Lands intersects the East Boundary Line of the J. Smith Survey No. 99;

Thence North along the East Boundary Line of the J. Smith Survey No. 99 to the Northeast corner of said Survey;

Thence West along the North Boundary Line of the J. Smith Survey No. 99 to the center line of Buttonwillow Creek;

Thence, South along the center line of Buttonwillow Creek to a point where the said creek center line intersects the North right-of-way line of Antilley Drive;

Thence East along the North right-of-way line of Antilley Drive to the place of beginning.

PART 2: That upon final passage hereof, the property hereinabove annexed shall be zoned as AO (Agricultural Open Space) District.

PART 3: That, upon final passage hereof, the above described annexed territory shall be a part of the City of Abilene, Texas, and the property situated therein shall bear its pro rata portion of the taxes levied by the City of Abilene and the inhabitants thereof, shall be entitled to all of the rights and privileges of all the citizens and shall be bound by the acts, ordinances, resolutions and regulations of the City of Abilene, Texas.

PASSED ON FIRST READING, this 17th day of November _____, A.D. 1977.

PART 4: That upon passage of this ordinance on first reading, the City Secretary is hereby directed to publish this ordinance at least one (1) time in the Abilene Reporter News, the week of November 21 to November 25, 1977. This ordinance shall not be considered for final passage until at least thirty (30) days have elapsed after said publication thereof in accordance with Section 4 of the Charter of the City of Abilene, Texas.

PART 5: That upon passage of this ordinance on first reading, the City Secretary is hereby directed to have published at least one (1) time in the Abilene Reporter News, a notice on January 3rd, 4th or 5th, 1978, that a public hearing will be held in the Council Chambers of the City Hall in Abilene, Texas, at 9:00 A.M., on the 12th day of January, 1978, to permit the public to be heard prior to the consideration of this ordinance for second and final reading.
