ORDINANCE NO. 1150  
**2995**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, PROVIDING FOR THE ABANDONMENT OF A PORTION OF THE SOUTH RIGHT-OF-WAY OF NORTH 5TH STREET BETWEEN PLUM AND ASH STREETS; PROVIDING FOR REVERTER AND CALLING A PUBLIC HEARING.

WHEREAS, a request has been made for the abandonment of a portion of the South right-of-way of North 5th Street between Plum and Ash Streets; and,

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council that a portion of the public property as below described, should be abandoned and that said abandonment is in the public interest of the City of Abilene; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the property described hereafter, to-wit:

- Being 4' x 59' 6" of the South right-of-way of North 5th Street between Plum and Ash Streets.
- BEGINNING at the Northwest corner of Block 38, Original Town, City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas;
- THENCE 59' 6" along the North boundary line of Block 38;
- THENCE 4' at a right angle to the North boundary line of Block 38;
- THENCE 59' 6" along and parallel to the North boundary line of Block 38;

THENCE to the place of beginning,

within the City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, be, and the same is hereby abandoned, vacated and closed insofar as the right, title and easement of the public is concerned, except that upon destruction or removal of the present building or structure, said abandoned property shall revert back to the City of Abilene.

PART 2: That it is in the public interest of the City of Abilene to so abandon said property described above.

PART 3: That the abandonment provided for herein shall extend only to the public right, title and easement in and to the property described above, and shall be construed only to that interest the governing body of the City of Abilene may legally and lawfully abandon.

PART 4: That, upon final passage hereof, the City Secretary be, and she is hereby authorized and directed to certify a copy of this Ordinance, and file it in the Deed Records of Taylor County, Texas.

PASSED ON FIRST READING, this the 8th day of February, A.D. 1979.

After said passage, a Notice of the time and place, where and when said Ordinance would be given a public hearing and considered for final passage, was published in the Abilene Reporter-News, a daily newspaper, of general circulation in the City of Abilene, said publication being on the 4 day of February, 1979, the same being more than twenty-four (24) hours prior to the time designated for said hearing. After such opportunity for the public to be heard, said Ordinance was passed on second and final reading.

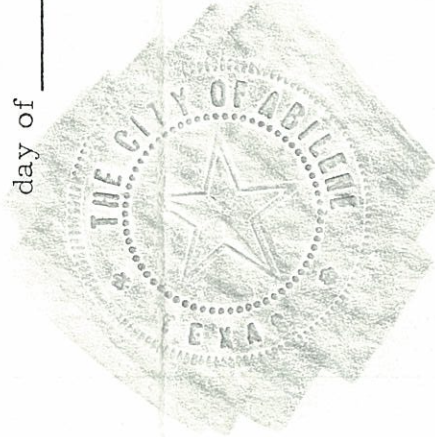
