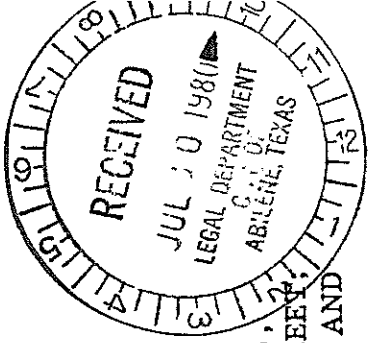

ORDINANCE NO. 58-1980

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, PROVIDING FOR THE ABANDONMENT OF A PORTION OF NORTH 14TH STREET, PROVIDING FOR THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SUCH ABANDONMENT, AND CALLING A PUBLIC HEARING.

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission of the City of Abilene has, at the request of Edwin B. Headrick, recommended to the City Council that a portion of North 14th Street, as hereinafter described, in the City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, which is neither needed, nor used, for public purposes, be closed and abandoned; and,

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council that such abandonment is in the public interest of the City of Abilene; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the following described portion of North 14th Street, within the City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, be, and the same is hereby abandoned, vacated and closed insofar as the right, title and easement of the public are concerned:

Being the North 20' of North 14th Street, from Austin Street east to Cedar Creek, such 20' strip abutting the lot which is on the Northeast corner of the intersection of North 14th & Austin Streets.

Such street being the same as that shown on T. C. Campbell's Replat of College Drive Addition to the City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas.

PART 2: That it is in the public interest of the City of Abilene to so abandon said above described portion of North 14th Street.

PART 3: That the abandonment provided for herein shall extend only to the public right, title and easement in and to the tracts of land described in Part 1 of this Ordinance, and shall be construed only to that interest the governing body of the City of Abilene may legally and lawfully abandon.

PART 4: That, upon final passage hereof, the City Secretary be, and she is hereby authorized and directed to certify a copy of this Ordinance, and file it in the Deed Records of Taylor County, Texas.

PASSED ON FIRST READING, this the 12th day of June, A.D. 1980.

After said passage, a Notice of the time and place, where and when said Ordinance would be given a public hearing and considered for final passage, was published in the Abilene Reporter-News, a daily newspaper, of general circulation in the City of Abilene, said publication being on the 1 day of June, 1980, the same being more than twenty-four (24) hours prior to the time designated for said hearing. After such opportunity for the public to be heard, said Ordinance was passed on second and final reading.

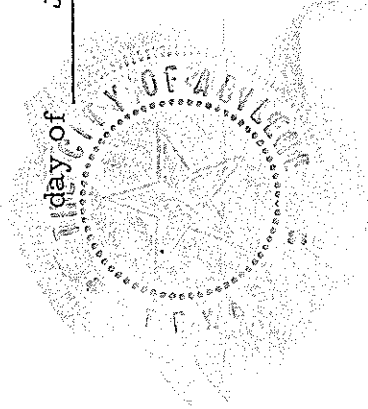
