

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, CHANGING THE NAME OF RESTWAY ROAD TO AMYLYN AVENUE.

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Commission of the City of Abilene that Restway Road, in the City of Abilene, which is west of Old Anson Road for a distance of 350 feet, should be renamed to Amylyn Avenue; and,

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council that Restway Road should be renamed Amylyn Drive; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That Restway Road, which is west of Old Anson Road for a distance of 350 feet, be renamed and will hereafter be known as Amylyn Avenue.

PART 2: That the City Engineer be and is hereby authorized and directed to change his maps, plats and records to include such name to be the proper name of the street described above.

PART 3: That the Planning and Community Development Department be, and is hereby authorized and directed to change its maps, plats and records to reflect such name change, and further that the Planning and Community Development Department shall provide notice of the renaming of such street to all other City departments including the Fire and Police Departments.
