

ORDINANCE NO. 56-1983

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 18, "MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC," BY AMENDING CERTAIN SECTIONS AS SET OUT BELOW; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND DECLARING A PENALTY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That Chapter 18, "Motor Vehicles and Traffic", of the Abilene Municipal Code be amended as set out in Exhibit "A," attached hereto and made a part of this ordinance for all purposes.

PART 2: That if any provision or any section of this ordinance shall be held to be void or unconstitutional such holding shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining provisions or sections of this ordinance, which shall remain in full force and effect.

PART 3: That any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this chapter shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00). Each day such violation shall continue, or be permitted to continue, shall be deemed a separate offense. Said ordinance, being a penal ordinance, becomes effective ten (10) days after its publication in the newspaper as provided by Section 19 of the Charter of the City of Abilene, Texas.

EXHIBIT "A"

Ordinance No. 56-1983

Amend Chapter 18, "Motor Vehicles and Traffic," Article X, Stopping, Standing, Parking, Division 4. Limited on Certain Streets by adding the following section:

Section 18-231A. Regulations Prohibiting Parking During Certain Hours on City Streets .

- (a) When signs have been erected at least 48 hours in advance in each block giving notice thereof, no person shall park a vehicle between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 7:00 P.M., of any day except Saturdays, Sundays, and public holidays upon any public street within the City limits of the City of Abilene.
- (b) Any vehicle found in violation of this no parking provision shall either be moved by a commercial wrecker service or by the City. The owner of any vehicle so moved by a commercial wrecker service shall be responsible for the payment of the wrecker service charge.
