

ORDINANCE NO. 59-1983

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS,
CHANGING THE NAME OF MINDA STREET TO YEOMAN'S ROAD.

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Commission of the City of Abilene that Minda Street, in the City of Abilene, which is east of South Judge Ely Boulevard, should be renamed Yeoman's Road; and,

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council that Minda Street east of South Judge Ely Boulevard should be renamed Yeoman's Road; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That Minda Street, which is east of South Judge Ely Boulevard be renamed and will hereafter be known as Yeoman's Road.

PART 2: That the City Engineer be and is hereby authorized and directed to change his maps, plats and records to include such name to be the proper name of the street described-above.

PART 3: That the Planning and Community Development Department be, and is hereby authorized and directed to change its maps, plats and records to reflect such name change, and further that the Planning and Community Development Department shall provide notice of the renaming of such street to all other City departments including the Fire and Police Departments.
