

ORDINANCE NO. 86-1983

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS,
CHANGING THE NAME OF HARWICK ROAD TO HARDWICK ROAD.

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Commission of the City of Abilene that Harwick Road, in the City of Abilene, which is between Antilley Road and Beltway South (F.M. 707), should be renamed Hardwick Road; and,

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council that Harwick Road should be renamed Hardwick Road; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That Harwick Road, which is between Antilley Road and Beltway South (F.M. 707), be renamed and will hereafter be known as Hardwick Road.

PART 2: That the City Engineer be and is hereby authorized and directed to change his maps, plats and records to include such name to be the proper name of the street described above.

PART 3: That the Planning and Community Development Department be, and is hereby authorized and directed to change its maps, plats and records to reflect such name change, and further that the Planning and Community Development Department shall provide notice of the renaming of such street to all other City departments including the Fire and Police Departments.
