

ORDINANCE NO. 10-1984

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 10, "FIRE PROTECTION AND PREVENTION," BY AMENDING CERTAIN SECTIONS AS SET OUT BELOW; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND DECLARING A PENALTY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That Chapter 10, "Fire Protection and Prevention," of the Abilene Municipal Code be amended as set out in Exhibit "A," attached hereto and made a part of this ordinance for all purposes.

PART 2: That if any provision or any section of this ordinance shall be held to be void or unconstitutional such holding shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining provisions or sections of this ordinance, which shall remain in full force and effect.

PART 3: Said ordinance becomes effective ten (10) days after its publication in the newspaper as provided by Section 19 of the Charter of the City of Abilene, Texas.

EXHIBIT "A"

ORDINANCE NO. 10-1984

- PART 1: Amend Section 10-1, "Arson Reward," by deleting the entire section.
- PART 2: Amend Article III, "Fire Prevention Code," Section 10-46 by amending Section 2.202(c) of the 1979 Uniform Fire Code as follows:
- Delete Section 2.202(c):
- "The City of Abilene offers a reward of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for the arrest and indictment of any person suspected of committing the crime of arson within the City. This reward is a standing offer and shall be paid out of the general fund of the City."
- and substitute therefore:
- "The City of Abilene offers a reward of up to Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for information leading to the arrest and indictment of any person suspected of committing the crime of arson within the City."
