

ORDINANCE NO. 121-1984

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 27, "REFUSE", BY AMENDING CERTAIN SECTIONS AS SET OUT BELOW; AND PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That Chapter 27, "Refuse" of the Abilene Municipal Code be amended as set out in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and made a part of this ordinance for all purposes.

PART 2: That if any provision or any section of this ordinance shall be held to be void or unconstitutional such holding shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining provisions or sections of this ordinance, which shall remain in full force and effect.

PART 3: Said ordinance shall become effective January 1, 1985.

EXHIBIT "A"

ORDINANCE NO. 121-1984

Amend Chapter 27, "Refuse", by deleting and revising sections as follows:

Sec. 27-91. (EXISTING) "The refuse disposal division shall provide refuse disposal service, operate sanitary landfills in accordance with Texas State Board of Health regulations and establish a system to assess refuse disposal fees under the provisions of this article. Said refuse disposal division shall have authority to designate refuse disposal areas as open to the public and hours of operations at and use of such refuse disposal areas."

AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS: "The City shall provide refuse disposal service, disposal facilities in accordance with Texas State Board of Health regulations, and shall establish a system to assess refuse disposal fees under the provisions of this article. The City shall designate the hours of operations at the landfill provided for public use."

Sec. 27-91.1(EXISTING) "A system of fair and reasonable classifications, according to the character and nature of use, set forth in Table I below, is hereby adopted to determine the fees for refuse disposal service to be assessed upon any person or persons disposing of refuse at disposal areas designated by the refuse disposal division as open to the public, other than disposals made indirectly through the refuse collection system."

AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS: "A system of fair and reasonable classifications, according to the character and nature of use, set forth in the "Schedule of Rates and Charges" kept on file in the City Secretary's office and the Refuse Division, per Section 27.95."

DELETE: Section 27-57; Section 27-58; Section 27-59; Section 27-60; Section 27-61; Section 27-62; Section 27-91.2

ADD: Sec. 27-65. "Fees, Deposits, and Bills."
The amounts as set by resolution, and procedures to be followed in regard to fees, deposits, and bills shall be as set by the City Council in a "Schedule of Rates and Charges" for the Refuse Division and kept on file in the City Secretary's Office and Refuse Division.

ADD: Sec. 27-95. "Fees, Deposits, and Bills."
The amounts as set by resolution, and procedures to be followed in regard to fees, deposits, and bills shall be as set by the City Council in a "Schedule of Rates and Charges" for the Refuse Division and kept on file in the City Secretary's Office and Refuse Division.
