

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, ESTABLISHING THE COMPENSATION TO BE PAID TO THE CITY BY TELEVISION CABLE SERVICE OF ABILENE, INC., FOR THE PRIVILEGE OF EXERCISING ITS FRANCHISE HERETOFORE GRANTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Abilene, Texas, in compliance with the procedures prescribed by the City Charter, granted a Franchise to Television Cable Service of Abilene, Inc., d/b/a United Cable Television of Abilene, to use the public streets, highways, alleys, bridges, public ways and other public places for the purpose of distributing cable television to residents of the City of Abilene, and, under the provisions of the ordinance granting the Franchise, provision was made to require Television Cable Service of Abilene, Inc. to make payment to the City of Abilene, for the privilege of exercising its Franchise, such sums of money as the Council may, by ordinance, determine, which such rate of compensation should be increased; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That Television Cable Service, Inc. be, and and the same is hereby, directed, under the provisions of Section 11 of Ordinance Number 86, to pay to the City of Abilene annually five percent (5%) of its annual gross receipts, from and after the 1st day of June, 1985, as defined in Section 11 of said Franchise Ordinance, and in full compliance with all the terms and provisions thereof. As heretofore set by ordinance, passed August 24, 1967, the rate of compensation to be paid by Television Cable Service of Abilene, Inc. shall be three percent (3%) of such annual gross receipts, prior to June 1, 1985.
