

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, APPROVING THE ASSESSMENT ROLL FOR 1985, LEVYING AN AD VALOREM TAX FOR THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, FOR THE YEAR 1985; PROVIDING FOR THE ASSESSMENT AND COLLECTION THEREOF; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the assessment roll for the year 1985, as compiled by the Assessor-Collector of Taxes for the City of Abilene, and amended and approved by the Appraisal Review Board of the City of Abilene, on the 19th day of July, 1985, be, and the same is hereby, in all things, approved and adopted.

PART 2: That there be, and is hereby levied, on all of the property located in the City of Abilene, Texas, on the 1st day of January, 1985, and not exempt from taxation by the Constitution and Laws of the State of Texas and the City of Abilene, an ad valorem tax in the aggregate total of ~~--- forty-eight and sixty-six hundredths~~ cents (48.66¢) ~~----~~ on each One Hundred Dollars' (\$100.00) valuation of said property, apportioned as follows:

PART 3: That there be, and are hereby authorized exemptions as follows:

- 1) Homestead exemption; fifteen percent (15%)
- 2) Age 65 and over exemption; \$15,000

PART 4: That notice for the public hearings on the 8th day of August, 1985, and the 22nd day of August, 1985, was given by publication in the Abilene Reporter-News on the 26th day of July, 1985, and the 9th day of August, 1985.

PART 5: That any ordinance, resolution, policy or any provision or section of the Code of the City of Abilene, Texas, as amended, in conflict herewith, be, and the same is hereby repealed to the extent of any conflict.

PART 6: That this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its date of final passage.

ORDINANCE NO. 71-1985

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR MINIMUM NUMBER OF FIREMEN AS SET OUT BELOW; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

EXHIBIT "A"

ORDINANCE NO. 71-1985

REPEAL:

That the initiative ordinance adopted by the Council on August 13, 1981, is hereby repealed and no longer of any force and effect.

ADOPT:

That the following ordinance dealing with Fire Department minimum manning is hereby adopted:

- (1) That the City will provide forty (40) firefighters per shift by January 1, 1986, and forty-two (42) firefighters per shift by October 1, 1986.
- (2) That the City will provide four (4) firefighters per piece of front-line equipment by October 1, 1987, by either paying overtime or adding additional personnel.
