

ORDINANCE NO. 71-1985

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR MINIMUM NUMBER OF FIREMEN AS SET OUT BELOW; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

PART 1: That the initiative ordinance providing for minimum number of firemen adopted on August 13, 1981, be amended as set out in Exhibit "A," attached hereto and made a part of this ordinance for all purposes.

PART 2: That said ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage as provided by Section 18 of the Charter of the City of Abilene, Texas.

EXHIBIT "A"

ORDINANCE NO. 71-1985

REPEAL:

That the initiative ordinance adopted by the Council on August 13, 1981, is hereby repealed and no longer of any force and effect.

ADOPT:

That the following ordinance dealing with Fire Department minimum manning is hereby adopted:

- (1) That the City will provide forty (40) firefighters per shift by January 1, 1986, and forty-two (42) firefighters per shift by October 1, 1986.
- (2) That the City will provide four (4) firefighters per piece of front-line equipment by October 1, 1987, by either paying overtime or adding additional personnel.
