

ORDINANCE NO. 32-1989

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 18, "MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC", OF THE ABILENE MUNICIPAL CODE, BY AMENDING CERTAIN SECTIONS AS SET OUT BELOW; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND DECLARING A PENALTY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That Chapter 18, "Motor Vehicles and Traffic", of the Abilene Municipal Code be amended as set out in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and made a part of this ordinance for all purposes.


PART 2: That if any provisions or any section of this ordinance shall be held to be void or unconstitutional, such holding shall in no way effect the validity of the remaining provisions or sections of this ordinance, which shall remain in full force and effect.

PART 3: That any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions of this chapter shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punishable by a fine of not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00). Each day such violation shall continue or be permitted to continue, shall be deemed a separate offense. Said Ordinance, being a penal ordinance, becomes effective ten (10) days after its publication in the newspaper, as provided by Section 19 of the Charter of the City of Abilene.



EXHIBIT "A"

Section 18-299, Parking Time Limited.

(a) Two hour limit: 8:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., Monday through Saturday:

DELETE:

<u>Street</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Extent</u>
Walnut St	East	From North 4th St to 155 feet north of North 5th St

ADD:

<u>Street</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Extent</u>
Walnut St	East	From North 5th St north a distance of 155 feet

Section 18-304, Parking Designated for the Disabled.

ADD:

<u>Street</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Extent</u>
Walnut St	East	From 40 feet south of North 4th St south a distance of 60 feet
