

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, CHANGING THE NAME OF **STATE STREET BETWEEN ASH AND N. TREADAWAY TO STAFFORD DRIVE.**

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Commission of the City of Abilene that State Street, in the City of Abilene, which is between Ash Street and North Treadaway Boulevard, and platted of record in Vol. 1, Page 546, on July 21, 1927, should be renamed; and,

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council that this street should be renamed; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That State Street between Ash and N. Treadaway, as described above, be renamed and will hereafter be known as Stafford Drive.

PART 2: That the City Engineer be and is hereby authorized and directed to change his maps, plats, and records to include such name to be the proper name of the street described above.

PART 3: That the Planning Department, be and is hereby authorized and directed to change its maps, plats, and records to reflect such name change, and further that the Planning Department shall provide notice of the renaming of such street to all other City departments including the Fire and Police Departments.

PART 4: A notice of the time and place, where and when said ordinance would be given a public hearing and considered for final passage, was published in the Abilene Reporter-News, a daily newspaper of general circulation in the City of Abilene, said publication being on the 5 day of February, 1995, the same being more than twenty-four (24) hours prior to a public hearing to be held in the Council Chamber of the City Hall in Abilene, Texas, at 9:00 a.m., on the 23 day of February, 1995, to permit the public to be heard prior to final consideration of this ordinance.
