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AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 23, "PLANNING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT," SUBPART E, "ZONING," OF THE ABILENE MUNICIPAL CODE, BY CHANGING THE ZONING DISTRICT BOUNDARIES AFFECTING CERTAIN PROPERTIES, AS DESCRIBED BELOW, DECLARING A PENALTY, AND CALLING A PUBLIC HEARING.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That Chapter 23, Subpart E, known as the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Abilene, is hereby amended by changing the zoning district boundaries as set out in Exhibit "A," attached hereto and made a part of this ordinance for all purposes.

PART 2: That any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this chapter shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00). Each day such violation shall continue or be permitted to continue, shall be deemed a separate offense.

## **EXHIBIT "A"**

Rezone property from SC (Shopping Center) to GC (General Commercial) zoning district.

Legal Description:

BEING 3.92 acres out of a 4.813 acre tract recorded in Volume 2217, Page 123. Official Public Records of Taylor County, Texas, out of Lot 1, Block 1, Westwood Plaza Addition to the City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, said 3.92 acre tract being more particularly described as follows:

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THENCE N20°56'W 411.22 feet to a 1/2" rebar found at the NE corner of said 0.89 acre tract in a curve to the right on the South line of said North 6th Street;

THENCE Along said curve to the right with a radius of 555.1 feet and a chord bearing and distance of N80°25'59"E 190.56 feet to a set 3/8" rebar at the end of said curve;

THENCE S89°39°E 241.90 feet along the South line of North 6th Street to the PLACE OF BEGINNING and containing 3.92 acres.
