ORDINANCE NO	. 56-2000
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AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 23, "PLANNING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT." SUBPART E, "ZONING," OF THE ABILENE MUNICIPAL CODE, BY CHANGING THE ZONING DISTRICT BOUNDARIES AFFECTING CERTAIN PROPERTIES, AS DESCRIBED BELOW. DECLARING A PENALTY, AND CALLING A PUBLIC HEARING.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That Chapter 23, Subpart E, known as the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Abilene, is hereby amended by changing the zoning district boundaries as set out in Exhibit "A," attached hereto and made a part of this ordinance for all purposes.

PART 2: That any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this chapter shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00). Each day such violation shall continue or be permitted to continue, shall be deemed a separate offense.

held in the Council Chamber of the City Hall in Abilene, Texas, at 9:00 a.m., on the 21 day of

ordinance. Said ordinance, being a penal ordinance, becomes effective ten (10) days after its
publication in the newspaper, as provided by Section 20 of the Charter of the City of Abilene.

## **EXHIBIT "A"**

Rezone property from AO (Agricultural Open Space) to RM-2 (Residential Multi-Family) zoning district.

THENCE S 89° 34' 00" E 1132.30' (referenced bearing for this survey) along the South line of said Lot 304 to the point of beginning and containing 6.000 acres of land.
