

ORDINANCE NO. 14-2003

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, FOR A STREET NAME CHANGE OF LOCH LOMAND TO ROAD RUNNER COURT, AS DESCRIBED BELOW AND CALLING A PUBLIC HEARING.

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Commission of the City of Abilene that Loch Lomand, in the City of Abilene, located in the Wildfire Estates Subdivision off of Griffith Road should be renamed; and,

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council that this street should be renamed; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That Loch Lomand, as described above, be renamed and will hereafter be known as Road Runner Court.

PART 2: That the City Engineer be and is hereby authorized and directed to change his maps, plats, and records to include such name to be the proper name of the street described above.

PART 3: That the Community Development Department, be and is hereby authorized and directed to change its maps, plats, and records to reflect such name change, and further that the Community Development Department shall provide notice of the renaming of such street to all other City departments including the Fire and Police Departments.

PASSED ON FIRST READING this 10 day of April A.D. 2003.

PART 4: A notice of the time and place, where and when said ordinance would be given a public hearing and considered for final passage, was published in the Abilene Reporter-News, a daily newspaper of general circulation in the City of Abilene, said publication being on the 6 day of April 2003, the same being more than twenty-four (24) hours prior to a public hearing to be held in the Council Chamber of the City Hall in Abilene, Texas, at 8:30 a.m., on the 24 day of April, 2003, to permit the public to be heard prior to final consideration of this ordinance.
