

ORDINANCE NO. 31-2004

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 18, "MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC" OF THE ABILENE MUNICIPAL CODE, BY AMENDING CERTAIN SECTIONS AS SET OUT BELOW; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND DECLARING A PENALTY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That Chapter 18, "Motor Vehicles and Traffic", of the Abilene Municipal Code be amended as set out in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and made a part of this ordinance for all purposes.

PART 2: That if any provisions of any section of this ordinance shall be held to be void or unconstitutional, such holding shall in no way effect the validity of the remaining provisions or sections of this ordinance, which shall remain in full force and effect.

PART 3: That any persons, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions of this chapter shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punishable by a fine of not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00). Each day such violation shall continue or be permitted to continue, shall be deemed a separate offense. Said Ordinance, being a penal ordinance, becomes effective ten (10) days after its publication in the newspaper, as provided by Section 19 of the Charter of the City of Abilene.

EXHIBIT A

Section 18-196, Parking Not to Obstruct Traffic

DELETE:

No person shall park any vehicle upon a street, other than an alley, in such manner or under such conditions as to leave available less than twelve (12) feet upon each side of the marked centerline on any two-way street upon which traffic lines have been marked and ten (10) feet upon any other street or alley for free movement of vehicular traffic.

ADD:

No person shall park any vehicle upon a street, other than an alley, in such manner or under such conditions as to leave available less than ten (10) feet upon each side of the marked centerline on any two-way street upon which traffic lines have been marked and ten (10) feet upon any other street or alley for free movement of vehicular traffic.

Section 18-286, Decreased Speed Limits – School Zones

(b) In accordance with the provisions of this chapter, and when traffic control devices or signs are erected giving notice thereof, the prima facie speed limit shall be twenty-five (25) miles per hour for hours designated on school days, where school signs are posted or at any time when electrical control devices are in operation, on the following streets or portions of streets.

Jackson Elementary	S. 27 th St	300 feet east of Marshall St to 300 feet west of Marshall St

Section 18-293, Parking Prohibited – At All Times

<u>Street</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Extent</u>
Beltway South (FM 707)	Both	From 300 feet west of White Blvd to 750 feet west of White Blvd
Mulberry St	West	From S. 3 rd St south a distance of 230 feet
Quail Run	Both	From Texas Ave north a distance of 120 feet

Section 18-299, Parking Time Limited

(a) Two hour limit: 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday

ADD:

<u>Street</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Extent</u>
Pine St	East	N. 1 st St to N. 2 nd St

(b) One hour limit: 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday

DELETE:

<u>Street</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Extent</u>
Pine St	East	N. 1 st St to N. 3 rd St

ADD:

<u>Street</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Extent</u>
Pine St	East	N. 2 nd St to N. 3 rd St
