Part 1.That the City Council approves the dissolution of the Municipal Golf Course Advisory Board

Part 2: Repeal Section 22-14 as presented in Exhibit "A"

Exhibit "A"

Sec. 22-14. Municipal golf course advisory board.

- (a) There is hereby established a Municipal Golf Course Advisory Board for the City of Abilene, Texas.
- (b) The board shall be comprised of seven (7) citizens of the City of Abilene and shall be appointed by the mayor with approval of the city council.
- (c) The purpose of the board shall be to make recommendations to the city council to assist in developing and overseeing municipal golf programs and courses to meet the needs of the community, specifically including: the enhancement of junior and women's golf programs by seeking creative ways to obtain public and private funding of municipal golf-through grants and partnering opportunities; and, to continually study and seek best practices in the industry to accomplish that purpose.
