

RESOLUTION DECLARING CERTAIN STREETS AND  
ALLEYS IN THE CITY OF ABILENE CLOSED, AND  
CARRYING AN EMERGENCY.

Whereas, several years prior thereto, there was filed in the County Clerk's office of Taylor County, Texas, certain plats designating and dedicating to the public certain streets and alleys in that block of land lying between South Ninth Street and South Eleventh Street, East of Rose Street, extending to Cedar Creek, and

Whereas, the City of Abilene has never accepted said streets and alleys and has never improved or used the same and the public has never used said streets or alleys or any of them as a public passage way, and said property has been treated and used as a solid block, and it would not be to the interest of the City to accept said streets and alleys, and it would not be to the interest of the public to have the same opened and used for such purposes,

Now, Therefore, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Abilene,

Section One: That all streets and alleys heretofore designated as lying within that block or tract of land between South Ninth Street and South Eleventh Street and East of Rose Street, extending to Cedar Creek, be and the same are hereby closed, and the City hereby rejects said streets, and the title thereto shall be vested in the owner of said land freed from any claim by the City to any of said land for street and alley purposes.

Section Two: That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
