Resolutions ~~NO~~-Ordering the improvement of Beech St in the City of Abilene, Texas, from North 6th St to North Seventh St; Specifying the material to be used and how and when it is to be paid for and by whom and appointing W.A.Riney to superintend the work and providing for an assessment against the property owners and the abutting property to secure the payment for said improvement ect. *also parts of Graham St and North 7th St. in said city*

Be it ~~enacted~~ resolved by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Abilene, Texas:

Section One:

That Beech St in the City of Abilene, Texas be improved from its intersection with North 6th St to its intersection with North 7th St. *Also Graham St from North First to North Second: also North 7th St from Beach to Orange St.*

Section Two:

That said parts of said ~~Beech~~ ^{Sts} Beech St be filled, raised and ~~and~~ paved with gravel to a thickness of an ~~average~~ averaged depth of eight inches from curb line to curb line and that cement curbs be erected on each side of said part of said St in keeping with the rules and regulation now in use by said City for said Curbs and that the abutting property owners pay the entire costs of said curbs when the same are erected and received by the said City: and W.A.Riney City Engineer be and he is here now appointed to superintend said work of paving and curbing.

Section Three:

Said Riney will at once prepared specifications for said improvements and filed with this Commission.

Section Four:

That the cost for said improvements shall be paid as follows: All the costs for said curbs to be paid by the abutting property owners on the acceptance of the work by said City: Each such property owner to pay for the curb in front of his property only. Each such abutting property owner to pay for one half ~~in~~ the costs of said paving, that is to pay for said paving to the middle of said St fronting on his property, that is on the front foot plan, the said City to pay for intersecting Sts and alleys: Said payments for said paving to be paid on estimates furnished by said Riney, the whole thereof to be paid on the acceptance of the work by said City: All the costs for said Curbing and paving to be assessed against the abutting property owners and thier respective abutting property according to said front foot plan, that is as the front footage of each property owner is to the ~~whole~~ whole footage to be improved after notice to and a hearing afforded each such property owner as by law required. provided that if the application of this rule in any case should be shown to be inequitable or unjust then said Commissioners will adopt such rule as will in their opinion be just and fair alike to all such property owners: provided that no such assessment shall be made in excess of the special benefits resulting to each peice of such property in the enhanced value thereof resulting from such improvements: This resolution to take effect from its passage and approval.
