Resolutions approving specifications for the improvement of parts of the following Sts in the City of Abilene, Texas; Beech St from North 6th to North 7th Sts/Graham St from North first to North second St: North 7th St from Beech to Orange St;: Specifying the material to be used and the nature of the improvements and who is to pay for the same and how and when. providing for the assessment against the abutting property owners and appointing W.A. Riney to superintend the work ect. and ordering City seretary to advertize for bids ect:

Be it resolved by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Abilene, Texas:

Section One: That the specifications for the improvement of Beech St from North 6th St to North 7th St and North 7th St from Beech to Orange Sts and Graham St from North First to North second Sts in the City of Abilene, Texas filed with this commission by W.A. Riney, are here now in all things adopted: And the City Secretary of said City will at once advertise for bids for the improvement of said Sts in the Abilene, Daily Reporter a newspaper of general circulation in said City for ~~the~~ three days as by law required: said bids when received will be in writing, sealed and delivered to said Secretary not later than FIVE O'Clock P.M. October 22nd 1920/. Said bids will not be opened until after ten days after the first publication and then opened by this Commission and acted on, reserving the right to reject any and all such bids and to accept the lowest and best bid for the City and abutting property owners. Said soecifications are on file in said Secretary's Office for the inspection of the general public. The City Secretary will make publication of this resolution as the advertisement for bids as called for.
