RESOLUTION AGREEING TO PAY THE SUM OF FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS TO SCHOOL DISTRICT NUMBER 39, AS THE PROPORTIONAL SHARE OF THE CITY OF ABILENE FOR THE UNIVERSITY PLACE ON BONDS NOW OUTSTANDING IN SAID DISTRICT.

WHEREAS the City of Abilene, did on the 20th day of June, A. D. 1924, extend the City limits so as to include University Place, said Ordinance being recorded in Volume 1, Page 587, Ordinance Records of said City of Abilene; and

WHEREAS the said University Place, described in said Ordinance, was a part of School District Number 39; and

WHEREAS there are outstanding School Bonds in said district in the sum of Seven Thousand Dollars; and

WHEREAS the Trustees of said district have agreed in writing, dated the 26th day of April, A. D. 1924, that said University Place might be annexed to the City of Abilene, and on the assumption of payment of only Five Hundred Dollars of said outstanding bonds; *by the City of Abilene*

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the said City of Abilene accepts said agreement and does hereby agree to pay the sum of Five Hundred Dollars of said Bonds. Said Five Hundred Dollars to be paid in yearly installments proportioned according to the number of years said bonds are to run.
