WHEREAS, G. W. Crabtree and wife Mamie Crabtree tendered a Deed dated December 17th, A. D. 1924, on the following described property, to-wit:

Being a Part of the East one-half of Block "B" out of the Northington Preemption; said land being. situated between Dhestnut Street and Oak Street, and more particularly described by metes and bounds as follows:
