RESOLUTION ACCEPTING DEED DATED
17TH DAY OF DECEMBER, A. D. 1924
TO ALLEY HEREIN DESCRIBED, GIVEN
BY G. W. CRABTREE AND WIFE MAMIE
CRABTREE TO THE CITY OF ABILENE.

WHEREAS, G. W. Crabtree and wife Mamie Crabtree
tendered a Deed dated December 17th, A. D. 1924, on
the following described property, to-wit:

Being a Part of the East one-half of Block "B"
out of the Northington Preemption; said land being
situated between Dhestnut Street and Oak Street, and
more particularly described by metes and bounds as
follows:

BEGINNING at a point 140 feet West of the South
East corner of A. H. Glasscock lot on Oak Street;
THENCE West with the South line of said lot 20 feet;
THENCE South parallel with the East line of Chestnut
Street 60 feet;
THENCE East and parallel with the South line of A. H.
Glasscock lot 20 feet;
THENCE North parallel with the West line of Oak Street
60 feet to the place of beginning; and

WHEREAS the said property was deeded for the purpose
of an alley and for the use of the public;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF THE CITY OF ABILENE; that the above described property and
deed to same be accepted and that said property be used for
an alley and for the use of the public.
