

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN
CONTRACT BETWEEN CITY OF ABILENE AND HENRY
SAYLES JR. FOR LAYING 600 FEET OF WATER PIPE
ON ELLIS STREET WEST FROM THE BOULEVARD TO
MORRELL STREET.

WHEREAS the City of Abilene has entered into a contract
with Henry Sayles Jr. to buy 600 feet of water pipe to be laid
on Ellis Street west from the Boulevard to Morrell Street, when
said pipe line yields 10 % per annum on the investment, said
contract being reduced to writing and dated August 14th, 1925.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF
COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE:

That the Mayor of the City of Abilene is hereby
authorized and directed to sign said contract for and on
behalf of the City of Abilene.

This Contract and agreement entered into by and between the City of Abilene, Part of the First Part and Henry Sayles Jr., Party of the Second Part, WITNESSETH:

Whereas, party of the second part desires to lay 600 feet of water pipe on Ellis Street West from the Boulevard to Morrell Street in the City of Abilene, said water pipe to remain the property of the party of the second part until said water main pays as much as 10 % per annum on the original cost and cost of installing, at which time the City of Abilene agrees to purchase said water pipe at the actual cost plus cost of installing same.

Party of the second part hereby agrees to purchase said pipe at the least possible cost and to install said pipe at the least possible cost and to render the City of Abilene an itemized statement of the cost of the pipe, together with the cost of laying same as soon as possible after said pipe is purchased and said work is completed, said itemized statement to be approved by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Abilene.

It is further agreed and understood that the City of Abilene will purchase from Second Party said water pipe when same yields 10 % per annum on the actual cost of said pipe plus the cost of installing same; the amount to be paid by the City of Abilene to be the actual cost of said pipe together with the actual cost of installing same, as per itemized statement above referred to and the party of the second part agrees to give bill of sale to said pipe upon receipt of said consideration.
