

RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID OF
R. J. ESTEP & COMPANY FOR THE
CONSTRUCTION OF A STORM SEWER
ON NORTH FOURTH STREET FROM MES-
QUITE STREET TO MAGNOLIA STREET.

WHEREAS, The City of Abilene advertized for bids for
the construction of a storm sewer on North Fourth Street
from Mesquite Street to Magnolia Street, and,

WHEREAS, R. J. Estep & Company's bid was the lowest
and best bid, said bid being as follows:

- 3 a. Same as No. 3 except depths 4 to 6 feet: " (\$.85)
- 4. Price per linear foot for trenching, laying and
completing a 30" Shearmon precast concrete storm sewer
according to specifications attached. Depth 0 to 4 feet:

- 4 a. Same as No. 4 except depths 4 to 6 ft. Dollars(\$ 4.60)
