

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN  
CONTRACT WITH PARRAMORE POST NO. 57 OF THE  
AMERICAN LEGION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF TEXAS.

WHEREAS, Parramore Post No. 57 of the American  
Legion of the Department of Texas, was instrumental in raising  
funds and promoting the bond issue to construct the present  
City Hall and City Auditorium and other civic improvements; and,

WHEREAS, the said Parramore Post No. 57 of the  
American Legion of the Department of Texas, desires to lease a  
suite of rooms in the Southeast corner of the basement of the  
present City Hall, now designated as the American Legion Rooms,  
for a period of five years, with the option of renewing said  
lease, and with the further provision that the City agrees to  
grant said option if requested to do so by said Parramore  
Post No. 57 of the American Legion of the Department of Texas,  
said agreement being reduced to writing dated April 1st, 1927,  
which is hereby referred to for the specific terms of said lease.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE  
BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE:

That the Mayor be, and is hereby authorized to  
sign said lease for and in behalf of the City of Abilene, and  
when so signed, shall become a binding obligation on the part  
of said City.
